Elective Units

- ACMVET202 Carry out daily practice routines (only students working in a veterinary practice)
- ACMSPE316 Provide general care of domestic dogs
- ACMSPE317 Provide general care of domestic cats
- ACMSPE314 Provide general care of birds
- ACMSPE322 Provide general care of rodents or rabbits



Entry Requirements

There are no specific pre-requisite knowledge required for entry, however you must:

- Have completed Year 10 or be a mature aged student
- Have a minimum of 8 hours per week of work in a veterinary clinic or animal care facility
- Have an email address, reliable internet access, and an ability to film yourself for assessment purposes
