- ACMVET401 Coordinate veterinary reception duties
- ACMVET402 Apply imaging routines
- ACMVET403 Perform clinical pathology procedures
- ACMVET404 Perform practice office procedures
- ACMVET405 Coordinate and perform surgical nursing routines
- ACMVET406 Nurse animals
- ACMVET407 Carry out medical nursing routines
- ACMVET408 Provide nutritional advice and support for animals
- ACMVET409 Provide specific animal care advice
- ACMVET410 Carry out veterinary dental nursing procedures
- ACMVET413 Prepare for anaesthesia and monitor animal anaesthesia and analgesia
- ACMVET416 Assist with the preparation of veterinary drugs and poisons

Elective Units (Required by all students)

- ACMGEN309 Provide basic animal first aid
- ACMBEH302 Provide enrichment for animals

Elective Units

Choose 2 that are appropriate for your workplace, some require regular handling and care of specific species. Only choose units where you care for these species most days of the work week.

- ACMSPE304 Provide basic care of dogs
- ACMSPE305 Provide basic care of cats
- ACMSPE302 Provide basic care of birds 1
- ACMSPE312 Provide basic care of rodents & rabbits



Entry Requirements

To be eligible for certificate IV in veterinary Nursing you must:

- Hold a Certificate II in Animal Studies (or equivalent),
- Have completed Year 10 or be a mature aged student,
- Have a minimum of 15 hours per week paid employment as a veterinary nurse
- Have an email address, reliable internet access, and an ability to film yourself for assessment purposes
